The Old Testament and Tithing

- Genesis 14:20 Abraham gives Melchizedek a tithe of spoils from his victory.
- Senesis 28: 20-22 In his covenant with God, Jacob vows to give Him a tithe from the Promised Land.
- Numbers 18: 21 The tithe is dedicated to the Levites for the work in the tabernacle.
- **Deuteronomy 12: 5-11** God gives instructions on what to do with a tithe.
- > Deuteronomy 14: 22-29 God gives instructions on how to disperse and exchange the tithe.
- **Deuteronomy 26: 12-15** God gives Israel instruction on how to sanctify the tithe.
- > 2 Chronicles 31: 5-12 Israel brings the tithe to the designated place.
- Nehemiah 10: 37-38 Israel obeys God and brings the tithes to the storehouse.
- > Nehemiah 12:44 Officers were appointed to watch over the tithes in the storehouse.
- Nehemiah 13: 5-12 Nehemiah restores order with the tithes.
- Amos 4:4 God commands Israel to bring back the tithe.
- Malachi 3: 8-10 Israel is reprimanded by God for not delivering the tithe.
