

# From the Pastor's Desk

Dear friends in Christ;

Summer is flying by. It gets to be 8:30pm and I am begging the sun "please don't go, please don't go!" I think we all know the feeling. We are so blessed to have the short summertime we have, some of the best weather in the world for so short a time and when it's here we are blessed beyond words. Notes of note:


