

A Message from Father David

These are the spiritual works of mercy with some practical suggestions on how to employ them to others' lives and in your own.

- A) To instruct the ignorant: Distribute Catholic literature (especially the Bible) to those who lack, teach your children and grandchildren in developmental ways the truths of Christ and His Church; volunteer at your local religious education program, if you don't know the answer always say you can find it, have Catholic Apps on your phone like <u>Laudate</u> and <u>Guide to Confession</u>
- B) To counsel the doubtful: To encourage those who doubt or disbelieve in their goodness before God and others; witness to those who struggle with the faith that you are praying for them in a special way; send cards, notes, letters, texts or emails to the doubting soul building up their connection to you and to the goodness of God
- C) To admonish sinners: Call a sin a sin but recognize your audience (try not to "bend the broken reed"); don't tolerate the behaviors of bullies, abusers, those who are publically intoxicated, foul mouths, pornographic story tellers and other anti-Christ like behaviors; tell the latter person or groups that you are "ashamed" of their behavior and that they need to work on becoming a better person and that you will lift them up in prayer while this happens
- **D)** To bear wrongs patiently: This mean "Biting one's tongue," "Turning the other cheek," "Giving over control," "Putting on a happy face," "Suffering in silence," "Making yourself interruptible," "Thinking before acting" and "Being the bigger person"
- E) To forgive offences willingly: Being like Christ, not holding grudges, forgiving and trying to forget the past, bringing (others') iniquities into the confessional and working them out with the priest, praying for the grace to forgive, meditate with Scripture on times when Christ was hurt deeply and reflect on how His pain relates to your pain, practice with the easier cases and realize that perfection takes time
- F) To comfort the afflicted: This relates mostly to those with mental/ emotional/psychological pain and the number one thing you can do for these is "be present" to them. If you have the appropriate boundaries with them, share signs of affection (hugs, holding hands, kissing, back rubs, brushing hair) to the mind through the body is the principle theory, but loving words make a great difference too. Being insensitive in words or action is contrary to comfort for the afflicted.
- G) To pray for the living and the dead: To use all occasions and all knowledge to lift up one's mind and heart in prayer this is the Christian's vocation. When you hear the sound of an ambulance or see a bloody scene on the news, when you hear of someone's death or the birth of a newborn, when someone bakes you a cake or puts money in a card for you, how do you pray for these? Prayer is for both the living and the dead and it is for you. The loneliest person in the world is the person who does not have anyone praying for them.
